







Turkey- Kyrgyzstan Joint Health Week (25 July – 02 August 2015)

92 operations and 623 patient consultations were performed during the 1st Kyrgyzstan-Turkey Joint Health Week which was held between 25 July and 02 August 2015 with the participation of health officials from the cardiology, cardiovascular surgery, general surgery, plastic surgery, gynecology, brain surgery and pediatric surgery branches from eight Training and Research Hospitals and a university in Ankara and Istanbul. The relevant preparations were prepared in June under coordination of the GD of Foreign Affairs and EU.







Within the framework of the Health Week; Dr. Talantbek Batraliyev, Minister of Health of Kyrgyzstan, Metin Kılıç, Ambassador of Turkey in Kyrgyzstan, Prof. Dr. Asılbek Kulmurzayev, Deputy Rector of Kyrgyz-Turkish Manas University and TIKA Kyrgyzstan Coordination Office was visited officially. Furthermore, the 1st Joint Working Committee Meeting was held under the presidency of Amangeldi Murzaliyev, Deputy Minister of Health.







An evaluation meeting was held on 31 July 2015 with the participation of Dr. Talantbek Batraliyev, Minister of Health of Kyrgyzstan, Metin Kılıç, Ambassador of Turkey in Kyrgyzstan, Amangeldi Murzaliev, Deputy Minister of Health of Kyrgyzstan, Dr. Mehmet Rifat Köse, head of delegation and General Director of Health Researches and Osman Can, Deputy Coordinator of TIKA in order to evaluate the outcomes of the health week and other cooperation areas.





In the meeting, the following issues were decided unanimously:

To train 2 specialists in each of the neurosurgery, pediatric surgery, nephrology/dialysis, medical oncology, cardiovascular surgery and organ transplantations branches for 6 months in Turkey to achieve capacity development. Training will be provided by the Ministry of Health of Turkey free of charge and transport and boarding expenses will be borne by TIKA;

To organize a health system examination visit for the Kyrgyz delegation who will arrive in August under presidency of Amangeldi Murzaliev, Deputy Minister of Health of Kyrgyzstan and ensure followings in this visit;

- O to provide medicine and medical device needs of Kyrgyzstan from Turkey;
- O To collaborate on the field of public health;
- O To share experience regarding social onsurance and reimbursement system.

Visit of Mr. Batraliyev, Minister of Health of Kyrgyzstan and hospital directors to treatment centers in Turkey after formation of the new government;

In addition to 15 personnel who will come to Turkey in August for Emergency Health Training, to provide training for the second group of 15 persons.













Mr. Batraliyev, Embassy of Turkey in Bishkek, TIKA Kyrgyzstan Coordination Office and directors and staff of 5 hospitals where operations were performed took great care of the Turkish delegation beyond the diplomatic practices.
